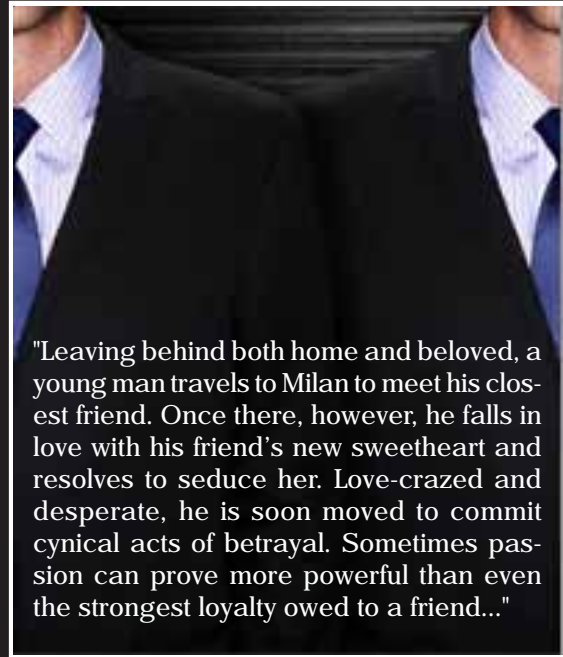

1. Register

2. Collect Contributions

Now it's time to get out and start collecting contributions! Be sure to collect all donations at the time you take the sponsor's information. All donations must be turned in the day of the march. Donations should be in the form of checks, made payable to Friends of Makoshika or FOM, if possible.



3. Come to the March

The march will begin at 10:00 a.m. Marchers need to meet at the Makoshika State Park Group Use Shelter by 9:30 a.m. to turn in their donations and pledge sheets. After the march there will be a hamburger lunch prepared by the Glendive Kiwanis, free of charge to participants.



On The Day Of The March

The march is approximately 4 miles. It starts at the Group Use Shelter, takes marchers to the top of the switchbacks, and back to the Group Use Shelter. Water will be available for marchers at the turnaround point. Traffic into the park will be controlled during the march to ensure participant safety. Please plan to arrive by 9:30 a.m. for check-in.



Why Participate ?

For over 20 years, Friends of Makoshika has been working to bring safe, fun outdoor experiences to local residents and their guests. Past projects include a group use shelter, amphitheater renovation, disc golf course improvements, souvenir merchandise in the visitor center gift shop, and over ten years of educational and special events programming.
